Impact Detail for: ORC 173.381(C)(2)(c), (F) Self-employed long-term care provider -- ineligibility for certification

Description: A community-based long-term care provider must be certified by the Ohio Department of Aging, or must have a department-approved grant or contract, in order to receive payment for services under a program the Department of Aging administers. ORC 173.39; ORC 173.392. A criminal records check is required of any self-employed ("non-agency") provider applying for a certificate. ORC 173.381(C)(2)(c), (F). For many providers, additional criminal records checks are required at least once every five years to maintain certification. OAC 173-9-04.1(B). The Department of Aging cannot issue a certificate, and must revoke any existing certificate, if the self-employed provider "has been convicted of, pleaded guilty to, or been found eligible for intervention in lieu of conviction for a disqualifying offense." ORC 173.381(C)(2)(c). The department need not hold a hearing about the denial or revocation. ORC 173.391(E)(2)(d). A disqualifying offense is any offense under 130 ORC sections listed in ORC 109.572(A)(3). ORC 173.381(A)(5). [EXCEPTION: A self-employed provider may receive or retain a certificate despite a disqualifying criminal record if the person meets standards specified in Dept. of Aging rules. ORC 173.381(I)(2)(d); OAC 173-9-07.] [NOTE 1: Several database checks are required in addition to the criminal records check, and results of the database review may also be grounds for denying or revoking a provider certificate. ORC 173.381(C)(2)(a), (E); OAC 173-9-03.1.] [NOTE 2: A provider who applies for a certificate and is denied must wait one year before reapplying. OAC 173-39-03(A)(3)(F)(II)(a).]
